Dr. S R Chandrashekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing	Two day seminar titled 'Fluency Disorders: Exploring the Tip and Depth of the Iceberg'	10 th & 11 th Oct 2025	25,000/-

The Department of Speech Language Studies, S. R. Chandrasekhar Institute of Speech and Hearing, successfully organized a two-day seminar titled “Fluency Disorders: Exploring the Tip and Depth of the Iceberg” on 10 and 11 October 2025. The seminar witnessed active participation from 35 professionals and 102 student delegates, with eight eminent resource persons contributing as speakers.

The event commenced with a keynote address on “The Changing Landscape of Fluency Disorders.” Scientific sessions covered a wide range of topics, including typical versus atypical dysfluencies, recent research in developmental stuttering, assessment and management of cluttering, psychotherapy and cognitive behavioural therapy for stuttering, the Lidcombe Programme, therapy for preschoolers, articulatory and kinematic perspectives of stuttering, and technology-based assessment and intervention.

The seminar was marked by engaging discussions and meaningful interactions, making it a valuable academic and professional learning experience for all participants.

MyISHA Chapter	Two day seminar titled 'Hearing Horizons 2025'	20 th & 21 st Dec, 2025	25,000/-

The Mysuru Chapter of the Indian Speech-Language and Hearing Association (MyISHA), in association with the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH), Mysuru, successfully organized “Hearing Horizons 2025”, a two-day RCI-approved national conference held on 20 and 21 December 2025 at AIISH, Mysuru. The conference was attended by approximately 200 professionals and 150 students and early-career audiologists from across the country.

The event featured plenary lectures, manufacturer-led technical sessions, hands-on masterclass training, a recruitment drive, focus group discussions, and multiple parallel sessions addressing current and emerging issues in hearing healthcare.

The primary objective of Hearing Horizons 2025 was to bridge the gap between academic institutions and private practitioners by promoting collaboration, knowledge sharing, and consistency in best clinical practices, ultimately enhancing the quality of hearing healthcare delivery nationwide.

The conference concluded with a strong public call to prioritize hearing health, encourage timely hearing assessments, and seek consultation with qualified audiology professionals for appropriate hearing aid interventions, thereby reducing the long-term impact of hearing loss on individuals, families, and society.

The National Workshop on “Emerging Trends in Multidisciplinary Evidence-Based Intervention of the Neurodiverse Population” was successfully conducted on 18 and 19 December 2025 at the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing (AIISH), Mysuru. Organized by AIISH, the two-day workshop focused on bridging the gap between research and clinical practice in neurodiversity.

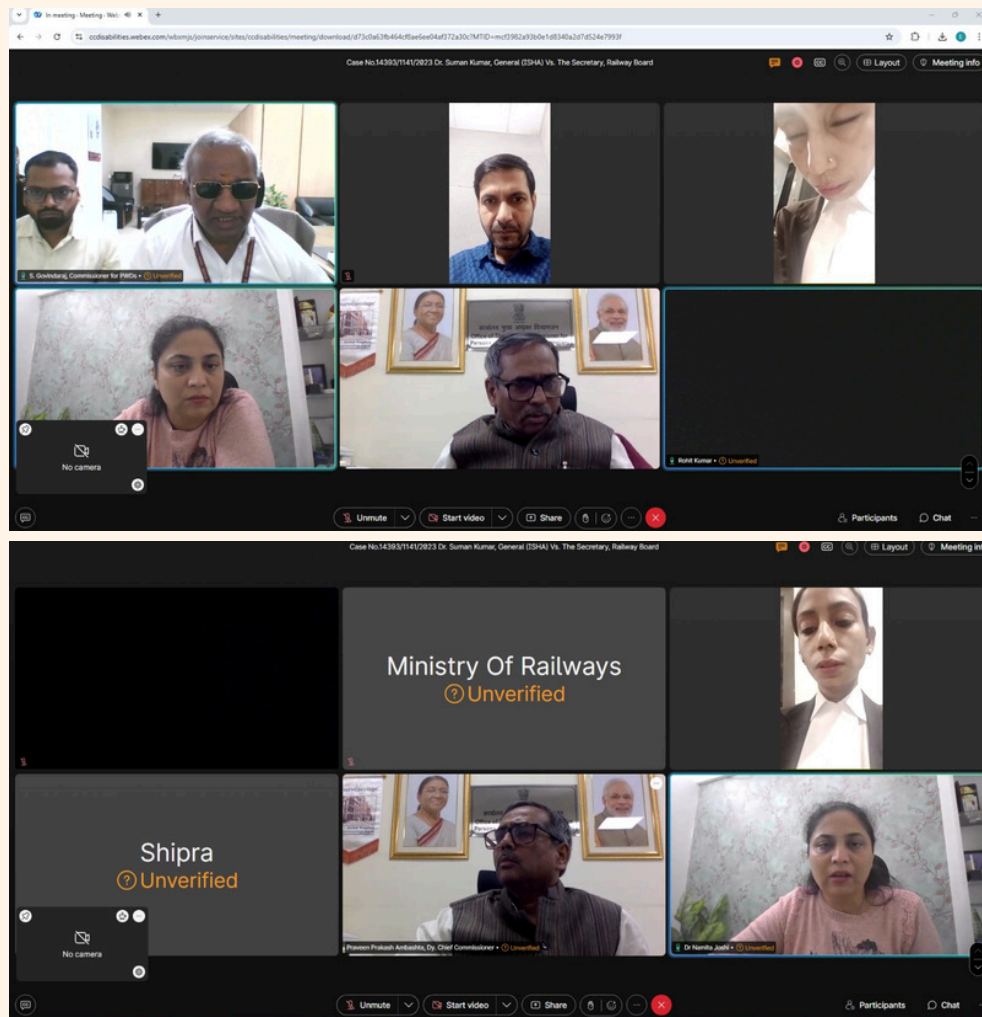
The workshop brought together Speech-Language Pathologists, Psychologists, Occupational Therapists, Special Educators, and students, offering updates on evidence-based, multidisciplinary interventions for neurodiverse individuals.

Key topics included Gestalt Language Processing, Sensory Integration, Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC), and technology-driven neuro-rehabilitation.

Through expert sessions led by faculty from the Department of Speech-Language Pathology, AIISH, participants gained practical insights into collaborative, technology-enabled care approaches. The workshop emphasized holistic intervention, social-emotional development, active engagement of neurodivergent individuals, and the critical role of parents in the intervention process.

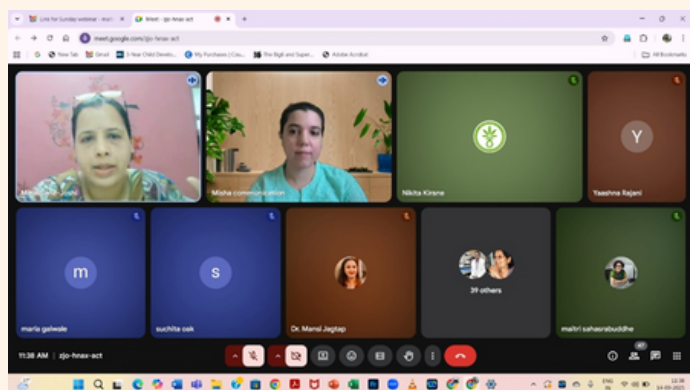


DISHACON 2025 –

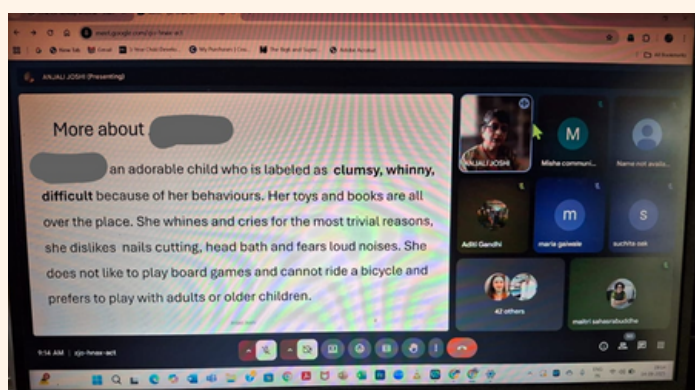
The National Conference on Best Practices in Speech & Hearing (DISHACON 2025) was successfully conducted by DISHA on 15–16 November 2025 at the JLN Auditorium, AIIMS, New Delhi. The two-day conference brought together 430 Speech-Language Pathologists, Audiologists, researchers, and clinicians from across the country for academic exchange and professional interaction. The scientific programme included keynote lectures, panel discussions, paper and poster presentations, and interactive sessions highlighting recent research, clinical innovations, and best practices. The conference emphasized advances in communication, swallowing, and audiological care, emerging technologies, teletherapy, interdisciplinary collaboration, inclusive education, advocacy, parent training, and community outreach for underserved populations.

An online webinar was conducted on 14th September 2025 titled “Building Blocks of Pediatric Rehabilitation”. The theme of the webinar was pediatric rehabilitation involving team members other than audiologists and speech language pathologists. A series of topics along these lines were covered by the resource persons Dr. Anjali Joshi (Occupational therapy), Dr. Krishnaveni Kannan (Behavior therapy), Dr. Minal Sane Joshi (Clinical psychology), Ms. Tabassum Pangarkar (Special Education), and Dr. Sadhana Ghaisas (Genetic testing and counseling).

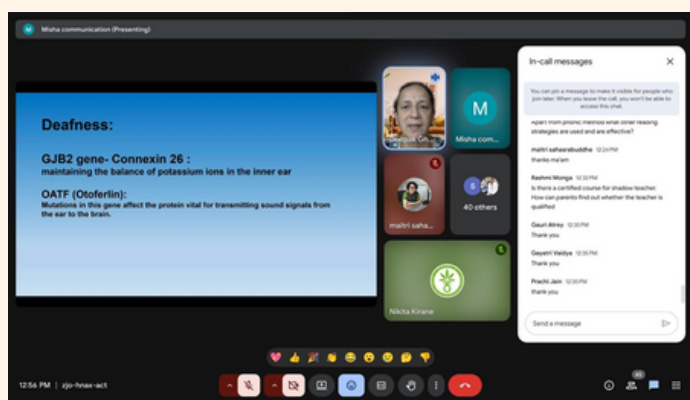

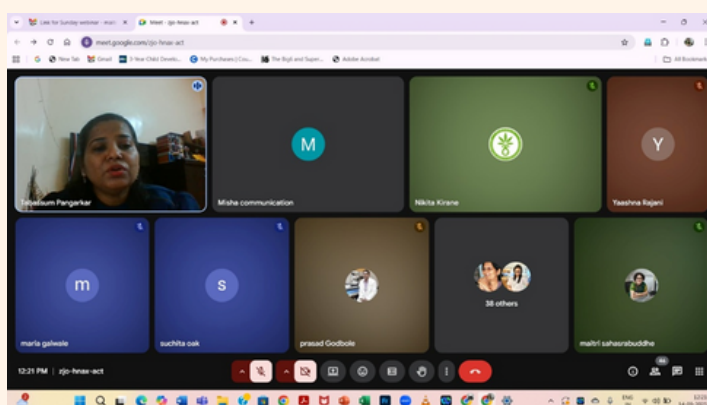

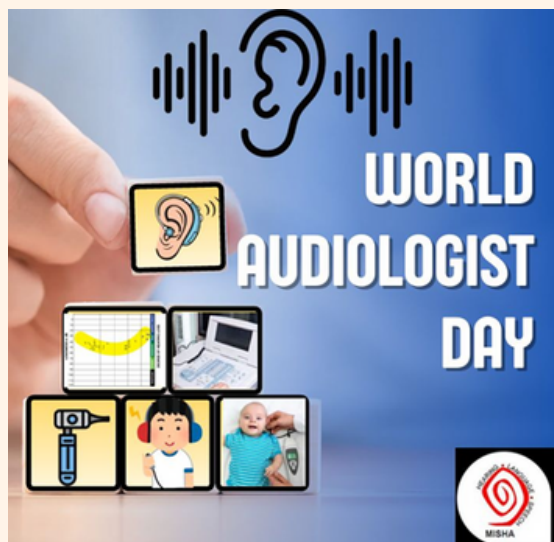

about behaviour therapy**

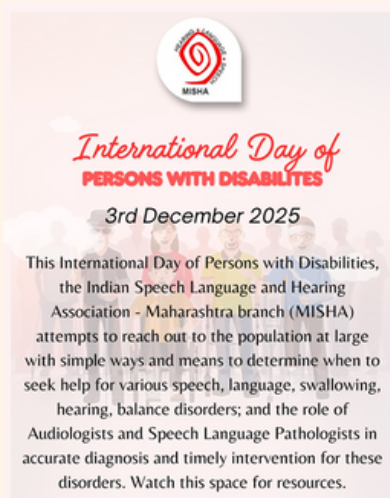

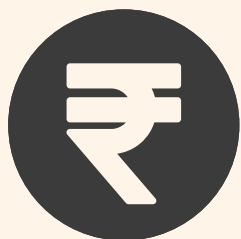
